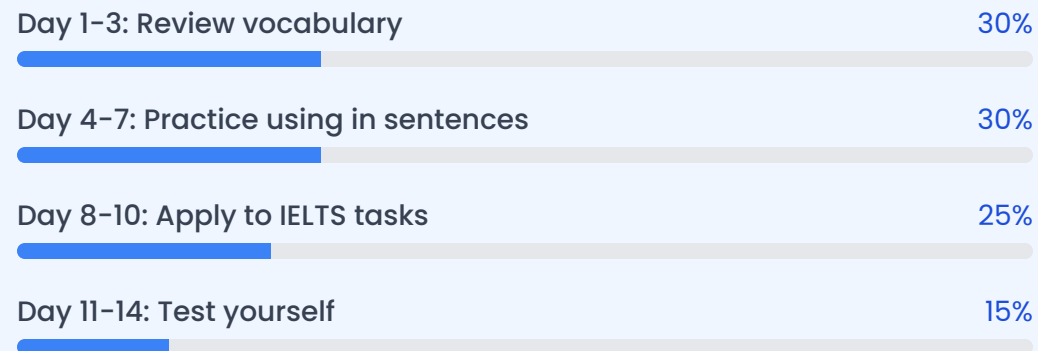

Tips for Using Vocabulary in IELTS



Use Vocabulary Naturally

Avoid forcing advanced words into your speech or writing. Use them only when appropriate to the context and meaning.



Master Collocations

Learn words that naturally go together (e.g., "address the issue" not "solve the issue") to sound more natural and fluent.



Practice Paraphrasing

Use synonyms and alternative expressions to avoid repetition and demonstrate lexical resource range.



Context is Key

Demonstrate understanding of words by using them in appropriate contexts with correct grammar structures.
